TRANSPORTATION

Dublin Bus

Dublin Bus provides a reliable 24-hour service, making it a convenient option for traveling to the Convention Centre Dublin.

Route 41: This route operates around the clock and stops at Irish Life in Dublin City. From this stop, it is a 16-minute walk to the CCD. Alternatively, passengers can transfer to line G1, which stops at Beckett Bridge in the Docklands, a mere 2-minute walk from the CCD. For detailed information on fares, tickets, and timetables, please refer to the Dublin Bus website.

Dublin Express

Dublin Express offers direct services that are ideal for those seeking a quick and straightforward journey to the CCD.

Route 782: Stops at George's Quay in Dublin City South, a 13-minute walk to the CCD. Route 784: Stops at Guild Street in the Docklands, just a 3-minute walk to the CCD.

Aircoach

Aircoach is another excellent option, offering routes that stop conveniently close to the CCD. Route 702 and Route 703: Both routes stop at the Clayton Hotel in the Docklands, which is a 6-minute walk from the CCD.
